Website v Actual Sizes Quick Summary

- Circa**
 - Standard is quite larger than website indications; X-Large are quite smaller than stated.
- Rollabind**
 - Small is actually quite larger than website indications; Medium is quite smaller.
 - Note that Rollabind does not say actual ring sizes, it gives depth of paper as the indication. I use this as the de facto inner ring size, as do most people.
 - Note that Rollabindsystems is just a corporate subgroup of Rollabind, same company, same products, although some different offerings.
- Remember**
 - Shris and raundry's DIY measurements were done in February, 2007. We have no way of knowing if these companies ever change their disc sizes through manufacture changes. Perhaps when or if they change suppliers; otherwise it would mean expensive retooling of the equipment.

Notes on Measurements

measurements were converted to 32nds as I only have an ordinary steel ruler to measure the discs I have, no electronic measuring tools and / or caliper's with 100th's units.

but it was also much more convenient for me to visualize sizes and compare in relation to an ordinary ruler; it may be so for others who likewise also don't have on hand for everyday use the 100th measuring tools.

a consequence of course is that measurements are not as accurate, with some rounding of numbers, but shris and raundry's original numbers are included in the map.

comparisons are based on 1" = 32/32

the /32nds usually not reduced, just to make comparisons faster

Amount of Paper

Levenger math doesn't make any sense.

1" (Large) rings = 150 pages, so you would expect 1/2" rings (Standard) to be half that, or 75 pages. However, they say 80.

If 1" = 150 pages, you would expect the 1 1/2" (X-Large) to be 225, but they say 200; if 1" = 150 pages, you would expect 3/4" (Medium) to be 112.50, but they say 90.

Using other sizes as basic standard don't work out either, so no idea ...

Rollabind

Rollabind math works out correctly so far as their given measurement sizes on their website:

1" = 120 pages,
1/2" = 60 pages,
1/4" = 30 pages,
3/4" = 80 pages.
